Old Business

- New EMS members (Alisha Vandenvond & Brianna Gudavich). - Both approved by all members to join EMS. Both will be presented to the Township board for final approval. Update: Brianna has dropped out due to scheduling conflict and will not be continuing with EMS.
- Medical First Responder Class – MFR class to start April 13th, the Township board has approved to pay for two people to attend. Alisha and Brianna are our current selections to join.
- Fire Dept rescue boat – Chris is requesting EMS pay up to \$2,500 for trailer for the new rescue boat. Josh made motion for EMS to pay \$2,500 for trailer, Kim seconded. All members voted in favor.
- Training Software – Chris advised the Fire Dept will be changing the company for online training from ATS to Fire Rescue 1. Yearly cost for EMS is \$477. Motion made by Tyler to approve cost of training. Second made by Josh, all members approved.

New Business

- Approve new member – Ryan Iacovacci: Tyler made motion to approve Ryan, Kim seconded. All in favor. Ryan will be attending MFR school with Alisha.
- Lifepak 12 battery replacement: One of the batteries in Lifepak 12 went bad and a refurbished battery was ordered and installed.
- Medical resupply from UPHS: Med box was restocked at UPHS. We have a few extra Epi-pens for adult and child now.
- CPR class to be held on April 22nd: CPR class will be held on April 22nd by Kim & Tyler for all Fire and Ems personnel.
- Repairs to Hall: Repairs to the hall are being scheduled to include fixing the thresholds to the main door entrances and adding a door to the kitchen. Future upgrades to include enclosing the loft area
- New locks for hall: 906 Technologies have offered to install new locks at the hall, and we will be switching to a keyless entry using a fob. A key box will be installed outside of the hall in case someone forgets their fob. EMS will be splitting some labor costs with Fire for the install.
