Public Comment: Public present: Marcia Gonstead, Don and Nancy Gaines. **Marcia reported on the gardening committee. Because of the dry spring, this year's planting will have to be watered and rabbit proofed. May use rain barrels. Field trips will help with moving forward. Marcia also brought up the Big Bay relay that was postponed last year due to COVID. Requesting that Parks and Rec plan for the third week of May for 2022. This is not part of Parks and Rec, Funds go to NTN. Items will be placed on the agenda for July.**

Reports

1. Big Bay Pathway (Sven) **Nothing to report at this time**
2. Burns Landing(Darlene) **Still waiting for Bill Sanders to determine costs and how we can move forward.**
3. Draver Park (Committee) **Talked with Bill Sanders at Draver Park about plans for the park, and was met by Daryl Small who mentioned money available through Alger Delta. They looked at the mechanical room between the two restrooms as a possible family restroom. Does not seem feasible at**

this time.

Discussion ensued regarding the amount of money parks and rec should request from Alger Delta to make the most impact with meeting our goals of an accessible park. We may have to pool several grants to manage it. Committee decided to request monies for outside water spigot, electricity for the pavilion, the cost of a temporary porta potty, and aggregate stone for an accessible pathway to porta potty. Porta Potty to be placed near the water tower.

4. Thomas Rock (Committee) **Sven thanked everyone who helped with the clean up. Weeds were pulled, railing fixed and everything looks really great!**

5. Concert Series (Sven) **Next and only concert for this year will be held on Sept. 18. Sub-committee will be needed to organize, including marketing, Raffle, etc. Will be planned at the July meeting.**

6. Community Garden (George and Lucy) **Need to plan where we want to go with the garden. Lucy and George will meet on Friday morning to discuss.**

7. PTR/Powell Trails(Sven) **Still need 4 intersection signs, we will add the cost to the Alger Delta request, and also ask the board to approve the purchase.**

8. Spaceport. **Lucy reported on the spaceport committee that has met twice. People who attended included: Carl Williams, Bill Ford, Jean /Jane Gertz. Public was invited. Gene Champagne offered to help, John Mallo and Frank Ziminsky are also interested. They will meet again in 3 weeks. Darlene is invited to determine the Powell Township Board involvement. Still trying to determine the steps of the process.**

1. Kubota U17: **Bids were presented by Sven. Lucy motioned to accept the bid by Ginop and Jill supported. Sven will check on delivery costs and purchase of a trailer. Lucy made a motion to authorize Sven to obtain bids for the trailer. George seconded.**

2. Burns Landing Rental: **Darlene reported on some research and determined that costs average between \$50-\$200 for 4 hours. Rental will include the restrooms, the boardwalk and picnic area around the homestead, and the pavilion. Discussion over pricing. Jill made a motion to charge \$50 per hour, with a four hour cap for residents, and \$100 per hour, with a four hour cap for non-residents. Deposit equal to rent. Darlene seconded. Signage for rentals will have to be available.**
