Cross Connections Ordinance

An ordinance regulating cross connections with the public water supply system i.e., a connection or arrangement of piping or appurtenances through which water of questionable quality, wastes, or other contaminates can enter the public water supply system.

Be it ordained by the Township of Powell, State of Michigan:

- Section 1. That the Township of Powell, adopts by reference the Water Supply Cross Connections Rules of Michigan Department of Public Health being R 325.431 to R 325.440 of the Michigan Administrative Code.
- Section 2. That it shall be the duty of the Township of Powell Board to cause inspections to be made of all properties served by the public water supply where cross connections with the public water supply is deemed possible. The frequency of inspections and re-inspections based on potential health hazards involved, shall be as established by the Powell Township Water Department and as approved by the Michigan Department of Public Health.
- Section 3. That the representative of the Powell Township Water Dept. shall have the right to enter at any reasonable time any property served by a connection to the public water supply system of the Township of Powell for the purpose of inspecting the piping system or systems thereof for cross connections. On request, the owner, lessees, or occupants of any property so served shall furnish to the inspection agency any pertinent information regarding the piping system or systems on such property. The refusal of such information or refusals of access, when requested, shall be deemed evidence of the presence of cross connections.
- Section 4. That the Powell Township Water Department is hereby authorized and directed to discontinue water service after reasonable notice to any property wherein any connection in violation of this ordinance exists and to take such other precautionary measures deemed necessary to eliminate any danger of contamination of the public water supply system. Water service to such property shall not be restored until the cross connection(s) has been eliminated in compliance with the provision of this ordinance.
