Inter-local Agreement for Creation of Senior Commission

WHEREAS,

- Request through resolutions of each governmental unit that the Marquette County Board of Commissioners immediately appoint, without a third party administration, a grass roots task force consisting of: one representative from the Commission on Aging, one representative from each Marquette County senior center, one representative from each local city and township represented. This task force is to address and report back within one year a priority of services to seniors and programs, and the possible formation of a County wide senior authority, which could be a new organization to fund senior services and programs. (As an alternative task force, consideration might be given to having five members appointed by the Marquette Township Association to replace representatives from all the townships.)
- Realizing that the senior mileage to be voted on in the August, 2006 primary will have an
 effect on the timeline of the appointed task force, the Transition Board recommends that
 the 2006 mileage be for one year and include funding for the Commission on Aging and
 Senior Centers to serve all citizens receiving services and any seniors on any waiting list.
- It is recommended that the Townships of Chocolay, Marquette, and Powell and the City of Marquette seek to finalize an inter-governmental agreement to control and manage the Marquette Senior Center.
- With the presentation of this final report of the Marquette Senior Transition Board, it is
 with the knowledge that each line of government will need to research and determine
 which avenue is best for its citizens to receive and be served in the manner needed.
