RESOLUTION TO APPROVE RENEWAL OF OPERATING MILLAGE PROPOSAL

At a regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of Powell Township, Marquette County, Michigan, held at the Township Hall in said Township on April 18, 2025, at 6:30 P.M.

Present: Daryl Wilcox (Treasurer), Levi Ellis (Supervisor), Stephen Girard (Trustee)

Absent: Sharon Mattis (Clerk), Denise Hudson (Trustee)

The following Resolution was offered by Daryl Wilcox and seconded by Stephen Girard.

WHEREAS, in support of an operating millage, the Township desires to levy a millage of 2.5 mills for a period of five (5) years, 2026 to 2030 inclusive, for the purpose of providing all Township purposes to the residents of the Township; and

WHEREAS, the Township Board has determined that placing the millage request on the ballot at the August 5th, 2025 election is in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the Township residents.

THEREFORE, the Township Board of Powell Township, Marquette County, Michigan, resolves as follows:

1. The Township Board resolves to present to the electors of Powell Township at the August 5th, 2025 election, a proposed renewal in the amount of ad valorem taxes as described in the ballot language attached as Exhibit A.
2. The Township Clerk is authorized and directed to promptly submit this resolution along with the above ballot language to the County Clerk so that the millage proposition may be included on the August 5th, 2025 election ballot.
3. Any resolution inconsistent with this resolution is hereby rescinded.
