RECREATION PASSPORT GRANT PROGRAM
RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE MATCHING FUNDS

WHEREAS, the Powell Township Board supports the submission of an application titled "The Draver Park Completion Project" to the Recreation Passport Grant Program for the completion of the 2023 Draver Park Renovation Spark Grant. Due to fluctuating material prices, several key components of the 2023 Draver Park renovation project could not be funded solely by the Spark Grant. Powell Township is seeking additional grant support to ensure that Draver Park is fully functional, as originally intended; and,

WHEREAS, the proposed application is supported by the approved Powell Township 2026-2030 Recreation Plan; and,

WHEREAS, the Powell Township Board is hereby making a financial commitment to the project in the amount of twenty-five percent (25%) of the project cost in matching funds from Powell Township Recreation funds.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Powell Township Board hereby authorizes submission of a Recreation Passport Grant Program Application for \$72,000, and further resolves to make available its financial obligation of \$24,000 (25%) of the total project cost of \$96,000 during the 2027-2028 fiscal year.
